That is what happened to mine, No broken springs, valve are not bent, but they are beat up from the concave washer going bad.

Nobody has them new, not even Porsche that I can find, so if you know of any, please let me know. I tried to replace them 3 years ago and couldn't find them then so I used some used ones and that's why they failed again!

Part number is #928 105 449 04 and we need 8 of them. Porsche sells them for \$6.00, but they are in Germany, we are still waiting on the ones ordered 3 years ago.
